

Blue Fish Sustainable Angler Best Practices

- 1. Dispose of used soft plastic baits, fishing line and lead weights and jig responsibly.
- **2.** Ensure live-wells, bilges and boat trailers are empty and clean to avoid transporting invasive species.
- **3.** Use minnows that come from the lake or river being fished or from a certified bait seller to avoid introducing invasive species or diseases.
- **4.** Learn how to selectively fish for specific species using the right sized tackle.
- **5.** Leave shore fishing locations and boat launches cleaner than you found them.
- **6.** Limit your personal fish harvest to one meal of fresh fish per outing.
- **7.** Follow fishing and harvest regulations, and harvest only those fish species that are in plentiful supply.
- **8.** Harvest fish lower on the food chain and release larger apex predators and the larger breeders.
- **9.** Harvest from put-and-take fisheries, and support fish stock rebuilding efforts by practicing catch and release.
- **10.** Report unethical behavior, tagged fish and water quality issues to relevant authorities.
